Day 1

Luke 9: 28-29

Praying is a major theme in Luke. Where is the place or time that you like to pray? When is a time that you unexpectedly knew that you needed to pray?

Day 2

Luke 9: 30-32

The word "departure" can also be translated "exodus." What is Jesus leading us out of? Where are we headed?

Day 3



Luke 9: 33-36

While Moses and Elijah had been important prophets, there is only one voice that we listen to: that of God. How do you listen for God's voice in your life? Tell about a time when you heard God somehow speaking to you.

Day 4

Luke 9: 37-40

This desperate parent is asking Jesus to cure his son. He has tried the disciples to no avail. Tell about a time when you had a problem and you tried everything you could but then realized the only option was to give it to God.

Day 5

Luke 41-43

Jesus seems angry with the crowds for their disbelief. What strengthens your faith and belief in God? Is it prayer, actions of others, witnessing a "miracle," your family, faith community?
