KBC AND LONG RUN FORUM

Recently, leaders from the Kentucky Baptist Convention and the Long Run Baptist Association have notified Crescent Hill Baptist Church that our welcoming and affirming stance toward LGBTQ individuals likely disqualifies our congregation from being in affiliation with these bodies. KBC leaders have informed church leaders that if we do not voluntarily elect to disaffiliate with the KBC that our affiliation will be brought to the floor of the KBC's annual meeting for a vote. On ***Wednesday, June 25*** at 6:00 PM a congregational forum will take place to give all interested the opportunity to share their thoughts on the matter.

SAMUEL CLAYTON WILLIAMS SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants will be asked to submit application by July 1.

Application will include:

Incoming Freshmen:

- Final high school transcript showing graduation in top 10% of class from JCPS high school
- Proof of acceptance into a school of higher education in Kentucky
- Member/regular attender of CHBC
- Essay on How "I keep it real". 200-400 words in length. Double spaced. 14 size font.
- Two character reference letters

Returning Students:

- Maintain 3.0 GPA and full time status, submit transcript
- Attend school of higher education in Kentucky
- Member/regular attender of CHBC
- Essay on "A life lesson I learned the hard way my first year of college." 400-500 words. Double spaced. Size 14 font.
- Two character reference letters (if reapplication, different letters than previously submitted)

Applications will be submitted to Andrea Woolley. Applicants' names will be removed and given a number for impartiality. A panel of CHBC church leaders will choose scholarship recipient by July 15.

Money awarded will be sent to the school to be used toward books, tuition, room & board. \$500 will be awarded for the fall semester. \$500 for the Spring semester. Students may receive the award more than one year; however, preference will be given to incoming freshmen. Only one scholarship will be awarded per academic year.
