### **SAMUEL CLAYTON WILLIAMS SCHOLARSHIP**

Applicants will be asked to submit application by July 1.

Application will include:

*Incoming Freshmen:*

- Final high school transcript showing graduation in top 10% of class from JCPS high school
- Proof of acceptance into a school of higher education in Kentucky
- Member/regular attender of CHBC
- Essay on How “I keep it real”. 200-400 words in length. Double spaced. 14 size font.
- Two character reference letters

*Returning Students:*

- Maintain 3.0 GPA and full time status, submit transcript
- Attend school of higher education in Kentucky
- Member/regular attender of CHBC
- Essay on “A life lesson I learned the hard way my first year of college.” 400-500 words. Double spaced. Size 14 font.
- Two character reference letters (if reapplication, different letters than previously submitted)

Applications will be submitted to Andrea Woolley. Applicants’ names will be removed and given a number for impartiality. A panel of CHBC church leaders will choose scholarship recipient by July 15.

Money awarded will be sent to the school to be used toward books, tuition, room & board. \$500 will be awarded for the fall semester. \$500 for the Spring semester. Students may receive the award more than one year; however, preference will be given to incoming freshmen. Only one scholarship will be awarded per academic year.
