KAREN GROWN COFFEE FROM THAILAND FOR SALE

Steve Clark and Annette Ellard have bags of coffee grown and roasted by Karen farmers in northern Thailand. The "Tobeebay" coffee 1 pound bags are \$14; 2 pound bags are \$25. There are three different roasts as well as whole beans or ground coffee. The coffee is not "certified" organic or fair trade; however, it is organically grown and fairly traded.
