COMING OPTIONS IN SPIRITUAL FORMATION

1. The History of Christian Spirituality: A 12 week course taught by Dr. Glenn Hinson Beginning on **Wednesday, February 18**, 10:30 AM – Noon, in the church parlor
A study of the way Christians have sought to deepen their covenant with God through the centuries from Jesus up to our own day.
2. Death and Eternal Life: What Cosmology, Ecology, and Eschatology Tell Us about the End of Our World; taught by Bill Thomason
Some day (in the very far future) the universe will come to an end. And every human being on the face of the earth (in the not-so-far- future) will die. How can we reconcile what science tells us about our origins and ends with what we affirm about God as creator of a good universe and the source of life? These are some of the questions we will address in the adult elective course outlined below. If you are not currently engaged in a Sunday School class (or are in a class that would like to take a break from its usual curriculum) and are interested in exploring these issues, you are welcome. This course, which begins on **February 8**, will be hosted by the Solidarity Sunday School class and will meet at 9:30 AM in Heritage Hall.
