CHURCH INVENTORY IN PROCESS

The Finance Team recently started the task of taking an inventory of the church's assets including the building. Members of many Sunday School classes are serving as those room's coordinators for this task. Not only is a written description of the room's contents being done, but photographs of the rooms are also being taken. Glen Skaggs provides the photography assistance to members of the Finance Team in compiling this inventory. During this initial phase of the inventory, we record what furniture, equipment, electronic equipment and pictures are in each room at that time. Supplies, books and toys are not being identified except by photographs. We envision videotaping each room to also record the rooms' contents. This inventory is being undertaken not only for insurance purposes but for our knowledge. The records will be kept off-site for security purposes.
