Dr. Babar, a physician and Pakistani native, has helped organize numerous interfaith public service projects and has been a voice for the local Muslim community in the aftermath of the 9/11 attacks and has formed a close relationship with the mayor of Louisville to coordinate meetings between Muslim, Christian, and Jewish leaders. **Imam Iqbal** grew up in Baltimore, MD and started studying Quran at a young age. He memorized the entire Quran by the age of 13. He has been serving as Imam at the Louisville Islamic Center since 2008. Imam Wasif lives in the greater Louisville area with his wife, daughter and son.
