HELP CO-SPONSOR A REFUGEE FAMILY

Recently, CHBC agreed to co-sponsor a family of Syrian refugees. Co-sponsors assist newly resettled refugees adjust to life in the United States for the first 90 days the refugees are in the country. Kentucky Refugee Ministries notified us on August 17 that a family of four from Syria could use our help beginning August 30, when they are slated to arrive in the United States. The family of four consists of a 27 year old husband, a 22 year old wife, and their two children, ages three and one. They have been refugees since 2012. This is an unusually short time frame in which to initiate help, but the family needs it and I believe we can provide it. We will need your help to make it happen, obviously. Fortunately, Mila Lee Chee has agreed to coordinate our resettlement assistance efforts.

Those interested in having direct contact with the family, meeting them at the airport, visiting the family, transporting the family to appointments, helping them to adjust to life in the United States for their first three months in this country, must undergo an orientation session. The orientation will take place at noon on Sunday, August 28.

Other ways that you can assist beyond direct interaction:

1. Furniture and household goods donations!
Co-sponsoring churches are expected to help furnish the apartment. A registry of what is needed will be posted on the church website as soon as possible.
2. Financial donations! We would like to raise enough money to cover the family's first three months of rent, roughly \$2,500. Donations can be made to CHBC and designated "Syrian Refugee Resettlement."
