NEW GENERAL ENTRANCE DOOR PROCEDURE

In order to provide a higher degree of security for all people who work, learn, and visit the church, a new automated lock has been installed on the General Entrance Door. During the week (Monday-Friday from 9-5) the door typically will be locked. The door will be unlocked when regular church activities take place on Wednesday evenings, Sunday morning, etc. Two buzzers have been installed next to the door. One will buzz the CHBC office. The other will buzz the HLS office. A camera and intercom are mounted next to the exterior door enabling staff or volunteers in the church office to see who is at the door and communicate with the person if need be. The door can be quickly, remotely unlocked so that visitors can be allowed access to the building. System installation is complete. As is the case with all things new, there will likely be a few wrinkles to iron out initially. Please bear with us.
