1 VOICE PRAYER GATHERING

On **Friday evening, September 1**, Crescent Hill Baptist will host the 1 Voice Prayer Gathering at 6:00 PM. The program will include several prayers as well as music led by Rev. Jeff Johnson and the Rivers of Living Water Band. 1 Voice Prayer Movement unites Christian Churches across racial, denominational and cultural lines to pray with 1 Voice for our city, state, nation & world that God's justice will prevail on behalf of the poor & oppressed. We are many ethnicities, comprised of multiple Christian traditions but we remain 1 in focus, 1 in purpose and 1 in commitment. We meet the first Friday of each month at a different host church. It lasts only one hour. In 2009, 1 Voice Prayer Movement was birthed and sent forth from St. Stephen

Church; Rev. Kevin W. Cosby, Pastor. Rev. Frank Smith, Jr. serves as the Shepherd of 1 Voice Prayer Movement.

UCHM FOOD CLOSET/BENEVOLENCE OFFERING

On the first Sunday of each month we collect *food items* for UCHM. The Food Pantry has a great need for food items that are good protein sources, such as cans of tuna, salmon, chicken, beef stew or peanut butter. Bring your items to the container in the church office. A *benevolence offering* is also taken at the end of the service to assist persons in need in our community. UCHM NEEDS PEER TUTORS AND VOLUNTEERS

UCHM is currently recruiting volunteers and peer tutors to assist in providing homework help and enrichment activities to youth participants in grades K-8 during the UCHM After-school Program. Peer tutors are exceptional students in grades 6-12 who have excelled in one or more subject areas who provide one-on-one tutoring to a student at least three grade levels below them. In addition, UCHM is also recruiting After-school program volunteers, who are 18 and up, to provide homework help to youth and assist with general program activities. The overarching goal of the UCHM After-school program is to help students achieve academic success as well as demonstrate positive behavior and social interactions with peers and adults. The UCHM After-school program begins **September 6** and runs M-F from 3:00 - 6:00 PM. We ask that peer tutors and volunteers commit to at least one day each week during the school year to volunteer with the program.
