### **ADVENT BOOK 2017**

"While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them." Luke 2:6-7

Throughout the ages, newly born babies have been wrapped up soon after their arrival to stay warm. Like other newly born babies, the gospel of Luke tells us that Jesus was wrapped in swaddling clothes or some type of blanket soon after his birth.

During the Advent season we wait to celebrate once more the birth of Christ. Throughout the ages, as people have waited, people have swapped stories with one another. Again this year, we will compile an Advent Devotional Booklet comprised of submissions from members of the Crescent Hill Baptist Church community.

Since some type of blanketing is central to the birth narrative, this year we want to encourage submitters to share a story of a significant blanket or quilt in your life that tells a story about faith, birth, life, family, memories, change, etc.
