While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them. Luke 2:6-7

Throughout the ages, newborn babies have been wrapped up soon after their arrival to stay warm. The gospel of Luke tells us that, like other newborn babies, Jesus was wrapped in swaddling clothes or some type of blanket soon after his birth.
