
101: What's An IXP

The primary role of an Internet exchange point is to

•keep local Internet traffic within local infrastructure and


•to the reduce costs associated with traffic exchange between Internet Service Providers (ISPs).

The Efficiency of the Internet




For any two parties who wish to exchange Internet traffic, there must be a pair of Internet exchanges, one near each party.

The Manifestation of Inefficiency



Countries which have not yet built IXPs disadvantage themselves, and needlessly export capital to countries that already have


