**Share Options**

\_\_\_ Market Share: This is very similar to the Regular Small with more flexibility for the member. You can choose the two different greens you want from the table and then take up to an additional \$6 value of veggies of your choice. This is ONLY available at the Newark pick-up.

\_\_\_ Regular Small: This size is great for a single person, couple, or family who sources seasonal produce from other farms. At \$12 per week you can expect a salad green (such as lettuce or arugula), one root crop (beets, carrots, radishes, etc.), and two or three seasonal crops (something like peas and spinach in the spring, tomatoes and peppers in the summer, broccoli and sweet potatoes in the fall).

\_\_\_ Regular Large: This is the perfect option for a larger family or a vegetarian/vegan house. At \$22 per week you can expect a salad green, a cooking green, an allium (onion family), an herb, a root crop and three to four seasonal crops.

\*\*\* Berry Share will continue this year. It includes 10 weeks of berries during early and mid summer for \$6 per week totaling \$60 for the season.

We do our best to ensure that you receive the value you have paid for per week. However, if the weather or pests make it impossible to do so in any given week please know that we will augment following shares to make up for it. If you have any food allergies or specific dietary conditions, please let us know and we will do what we can to accommodate your needs.

## Payment Options

\_\_\_\_\_ Early Bird: Payment in full (single payment) prior to February 24. (Deduct \$25)

\_\_\_\_\_ Member Work Discount: I will work at least one shift (3 hours) in the 2015 season. Jobs available are weeding/planting in the garden, working at farmer's market, helping organize/run events. Your availability to volunteer will determine your discount.

\_\_\_\_\_ Refer a new member: Know a friend, neighbor, co-worker who's interested in joining? If they do sign up you'll both receive a \$20 discount!

\_\_\_\_\_ Standard Payment Option: Deposit (\$100 minimum) \_\_\_\_\_. Remainder \_\_\_\_\_ due by April 1<sup>st</sup>.

## Some Logistical Details

A minimum non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required to reserve your share. A confirmation email will be sent to you when your membership is received and processed.

You may cancel a delivery with at least 24 hours advance notice. If some else is picking up your share, please fully explain the delivery system to them so they do not inadvertently take other members' items. Due to harvest and delivery logistics, we cannot accommodate changes in delivery sites or dates. There are no credits/refunds for missed deliveries.

Any shares not picked up within 24 hours of designated pick up time will be donated at your site host's discretion unless other arrangements are made.

Farming contains risks beyond our control. Sharing the risks of farming along with the benefits is a fundamental aspect of joining a CSA. We plan each season carefully and will work in good faith to fulfill our commitment. Like all small farms, we have years that are better or worse than others due to weather, insect pressure, seed quality and many other variables. We cannot guarantee the quantity or availability of any specific item.

CSA members are invited to visit the farm for scheduled work days, special farm events, or their own recreational use (hiking, picnicking, camping, etc.). Please contact us before visiting to make sure we are available.

Brewer's Hideaway Farm uses email as the primary method of communication with members. Please provide one or more email addresses that you check regularly with your agreement and be sure to update us if your accounts change.

We frequently take photographs of members at work days and other farm events. By signing this form, members agree that we may use photos of them and their family on our Website, Facebook page or other materials. If you do not agree to this use, please make a note on your membership form or send us an email communication.

### **Acknowledgment of Risks and Hazards: Liability Release**

By signing this agreement, members acknowledge that there are numerous hazards and risks inherent in being present on the farm and participating in farm activities, whether work or recreational in nature. While present on the farm, members are responsible for their own safety and that of their children or guests. Members freely accept responsibility for any and all risks of injury or death while participating in farm activities or while present on Brewers Hideaway Farm premises.

By signing this agreement, members agree to release, forever discharge, indemnify, defend and hold harmless Brewers Hideaway Farm, its owners, agents and employees from all liability for negligence and any and all losses, damages, costs and attorneys' fees resulting from any and all claims or suits for personal injuries, death and/or property damage of any kind while on the farm or after leaving the premises.
