

## WHAT TO EXPECT FROM HOMES OF HOPE SAN DIEGO BAJA

Accommodations: If you have chosen a standard package, You will be staying at the Youth With A Mission (YWAM) San Antonio Del Mar campus or Ensenada Campus. The facilities are VERY nice and you won't be roughing it at all! In Ensenada, they are all newly remodeled dorm-style rooms, all with private facilities. **What to bring:** On the build site: Backpack with baby wipes, sanitizer, sunscreen, camera and some cash (we might build near a store so you can buy a soda/souvenir and sometimes locals come selling their wares) – feel free to bring snacks but food is provided.

Bring toiletries – your room will have hand soap. Please pack all other toiletries you will need. I also pack a loofa for quick paint removal!

**This is what I generally pack for a 2 night stay:** *1 outfit to build in (it gets ruined so we always wear the same thing on both build days)*, baseball cap, sunglasses, 2 pair jeans and/or shorts, 3 shirts, and a sweater. My girls bring: 1 work outfit, baseball cap, sunglasses, 1 pair jeans, 1 pair shorts, 3 shirts and a sweatshirt.

While at the YWAM Campus: YWAM is a fully volunteer organization. All of the staff serving your meals and taking care of our trip rely solely on support – NO ONE collects a salary!! With that in mind, please be prompt, and please strip your beds on departure day and leave your room as clean as possible. Anything you can do to bless the staff would be awesome!!
