

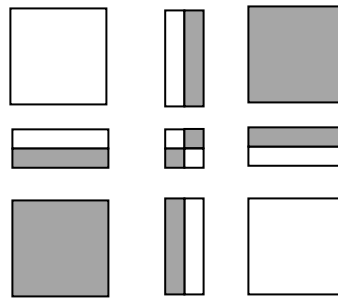
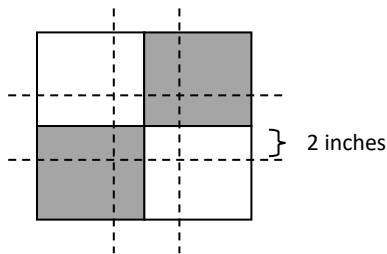
“Disappearing Four Patch”

This block can be made in any size. Missouri Star Quilt Company has a tutorial using charm squares. For this example, the starting pieces are 8” square and the resulting block is 14” square

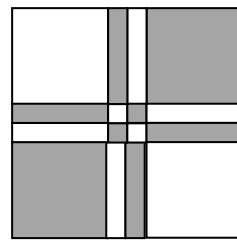
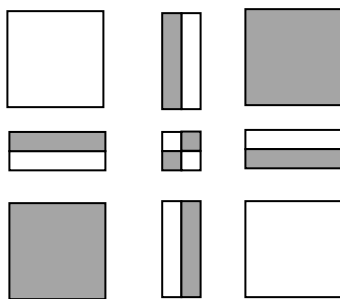
1. Sew four 8” squares into a four-patch block.



2. Make 4 cuts without moving the block or the cut pieces. Use a small mat so you can turn the block without disturbing it. Using the center seams as the reference point, measure out 2 inches and make a cut; then make a cut on the other side of the seam. Rotate and repeat, measuring 2 inches from the center seam for each cut. You will have 9 pieces.



3. Next, rotate the four center rectangular sections 180 degrees as shown in the diagram below.



4. Sew the 9 pieces back together to make block. Trim the block to 14” square.
5. This can also be done by making 4 diagonal cuts as shown in the photo.
