

## **Mini Fabric Journal**

Half day workshop with Sue Bleiweiss

Once you make your own blank book you'll never want to buy another one! This 6"x6" fun and easy to make fabric journal is the perfect size for tucking in your purse or carry on bag or make a stack of them to give as gifts. Filled with blank pages you can use it to keep track of your quilt projects, doodle, draw and sketch in! Not only will you learn how to make your own fabric book in this workshop, you'll also learn how to work with Mistyfuse fusible and an easy no-reverse appliqué technique that means no more flipping and reversing shapes, numbers or letters!

### **Supply list - please bring these supplies with you to class**

Note: I used solid color fabric to make my journals but you can use prints, vintage, reproduction or batik fabrics- the choice is yours!

Two fat quarters -one for the outside and one for the inside

Note: if you would like to create a collage of images on the outside of your journal like you see on the ones in the sample photo then bring an assortment of scraps or fat quarters to class to work with.

Sewing machine thread that coordinates with your fabric to use in the top and bobbin. You will use this to satin or zig zag stitch the edges of your journal.

Scissors or a rotary cutter and small mat

**Kit fee \$10** - I will supply each student with a kit that includes the following:

Timtex

Mistyfuse fusible web

Parchment paper

Blank paper for the inside of the journal

Button and elastic closure
