***The following items will be used in class:***

## ***Splash of Color: A Rainbow of Brilliant Black-and-White Quilts by Jackie Kunkel***

- Sewing Machine with a quarter-inch foot and accessories
- Steam Iron
- Ironing Board
- 6" x 12" ruler
- Medium size cutting mat (18" x 24")
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm
- New rotary blade
- Size 70/10 microtex needles
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Surge protectors
- Extension cords
- Glue Pen (Fons & Porter, Sewline or Avery)
- High quality cotton sewing thread 50 weight preferable.
- Pins

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***Fabric:***

***Yardage based on 42" wide fabric:***

- 3-1/8 yards of black print for sashing, middle border, and binding
- 1/2 yard *each* of 6 assorted white prints for blocks
- 2-1/8 yards of white geometric print for blocks and outer border
- 2/3 yard of teal print for inner border
- 1/8 yard *each* of 4 assorted orange, red, yellow, green, blue, and purple prints for blocks
- 1/3 yard of white with stars print for cornerstones
- 8 yards of fabric for backing
- 91" x 100" piece of batting

***Cutting Instructions:***

Please follow the cutting instructions on page 47 and 48 of the book *Splash of color*, prior to coming to class. **Tip:** Organize each "section" of cutting into its own Ziploc bag to keep in order.
