## Workshop Supplies and Prep *Picnic Petals* quilt



### Prior to class, please:

1. Complete **Preparation** directions on page 1 of the pattern.  
I recommend starching and pressing your fabric prior to cutting.
2. Read **Cutting Tips** on page 2 of the pattern.
3. Cut your fabric. If you don't want to fully commit to cutting all of the pieces for the entire pattern, cut at least:
  - Pieces needed for Center Block 1 (see page 2 of pattern)
  - Pieces needed for at least one Border Block 1 (see page 3 of pattern)

### What to bring to class:

1. *Picnic Petals* pattern.

2. Extra fabric (if you decide NOT to cut all of the pieces for the entire pattern or need help making final color selections). See next page for fabric requirements.
3. Templates you pieced from **Preparation** directions in *Picnic Petals* pattern
4. Prep work described above.
5. Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot or guide (If you don't have a 1/4" foot, bring blue painters tape—you can make your own 1/4" guide!)
6. Basic Sewing Supplies, for example:
  - Thread
  - Pins
  - Seam ripper
  - Marking pen/pencil
  - Scissors, Acrylic Ruler, Rotary Cutter
  - Iron (and a small travel board or pressing surface if you have one)
7. Notebook/Journal and pen or pencil for taking notes

## materials

<i>Finished Quilt</i>	Throw 63" x 63"	Twin 72" x 90"	Queen 90" x 90"
<i>Quilt Top</i>			
<b>Green</b>	<b>1¼ yds</b>	<b>1⅔ yds</b>	<b>2 yds</b>
<b>Magenta</b>	<b>1 yd</b>	<b>1⅓ yds</b>	<b>1¼ yds</b>
<b>Aqua</b>	<b>¾ yd</b>	<b>1 yd</b>	<b>1⅓ yds</b>
<b>Peach</b>	<b>⅔ yd</b>	<b>1 yd</b>	<b>1 yd</b>
<b>Silver</b>	<b>½ yd</b>	<b>¾ yd</b>	<b>1 yd</b>
<b>White</b>	<b>2¼ yds</b>	<b>3⅓ yds</b>	<b>4⅔ yds</b>

### *Additional materials*

<b>Backing Fabric</b>	<b>4 yds</b>	<b>5½ yds</b>	<b>8 yds</b>
<b>Batting</b>	<b>69" x 69"</b>	<b>78" x 96"</b>	<b>96" x 96"</b>
<b>Binding Fabric</b>	<b>⅔ yd</b>	<b>1 yd</b>	<b>1⅓ yds</b>

*based on cutting 2½" strips on the cross-grain (selvage-to-selvage) and then double-folding*

### *Yardage is:*

- based on 42" width of fabric (WOF)
- based on cutting layout diagrams (provided) then rounded up to nearest ⅛" yard

### **Other special tools**

- paper scissors or paper rotary cutter (to cut out templates)
- cardstock/heavy weight paper or plastic template material
- tape
- spray starch
- fabric marking tool
- *optional*—28mm fabric rotary cutter

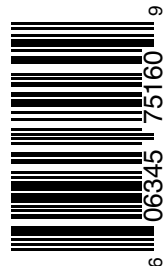
