ED ROTHKRAZ CLINICS AT BRIER BANK FARM

Brier Bank Farm in Marine, IL, is proud to present a series of clinics with Ed Rothkranz.

Mr. Rothkranz grew up in Germany. Upon moving to Canada, he was Reserve Canadian International Dressage Champion in 1974, Reserve Eastern Canadian Champion in 1975, and Canadian Advanced Level Champion in 1977. Mr. Rothkranz competed in the 1980 Olympics for Team Canada. He moved to the United States in 1980, and is currently known for his bloodlines of upper level dressage horses, having provided horses to the late Dr. Reiner Klimke and to Thomas Poulin. Mr. Rothkranz also provided the training and instruction of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, who perform dressage to music in exhibitions throughout the world.

Clinics will be held at Brier Bank Farm June 19-21, September 11-13, October 16-18, November 20-22.
