Juventus Cycling Club and the Alberta Bicycling Association recognizes Canada Day event in Lendrum Community in Edmonton, is on Treaty #6 territory. The land is a traditional meeting ground, gathering place, and travelling route of the Cree, Saulteaux, Blackfoot, Métis, Dene, and Nakota Sioux. Registration: Online at Zone 4 closing June 29, 23:00. Single Event License will not be available. Riders must present a valid UCI or ABA 2024 Race license.

LAMP and Youth doing both the Canada Day Crit and the LINO BOVO Youth Track Meet on June 30th **must register for each event on Zone 4**. Payment may be made on either registration page.

Race Numbers: If you have already received your 2024 ABA numbers, please wear them for this race. If this is your first ABA race, you will be assigned your race numbers here. A gentle reminder that failing to bring your personal race numbers – should you have them – is a \$10 replacement cost. Please ensure that you have your numbers well before your start time.

License Check & Sign-on: ABA license must be shown at sign on. Sign-on closes 15 min before your start time. Sign on will open at 8:20am.

Juventus LAMP and Sprockids: Enter 000 for race number.

Kids Ride: The younger kids will do one lap. Older kids will race 2 laps with Sprockids. **Do not register** - just show at the start line 10 minutes before the event. Free race entry includes freezie.

Washrooms: We will have portable toilets at the finish line only. There will also be toilets in the community hall. **No public urination, you will be disqualified from event**.

Race Format:

- Citizen event will be a first to cross line event.
- LAMP and Sprockids will be first to cross the line events.
- The category races will be a points format. Points will be awarded every 4 laps. 5, 3, 2 & 1 points to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place rider across the line. Double points on the last sprint 10, 6, 4 & 2 for top 1st 4th placings.
- Riders lapping the field will be a lap up and all riders will finish on the same lap as the leader.
- The bell will be rung at the beginning of each sprint lap. Points will only be awarded if the bell is rung.
- A bell will signify the last lap. A lap board will be used to signify the remaining laps.
- Individual riders lapped by the lead motorcycle will be pulled from the race at the discretion of the commissaire.
- There will be no feeding of riders during the race. (Riders may feed themselves :)
- Final ranking will be based on most laps completed, then total points earned, then placing on the final sprint.





Number Placement: two numbers, right ribcage, right lower back + frame plate



Regulations: This event will be run according to ABA/CC/UCI regulations. Riders are responsible for knowing and understanding the rules. They are available online.

Wheel Pit: Wheel pit is located south of the start / finish area. It is the rider's responsibility to supply wheels identified by your race number. Riders may receive one free lap for a crash or mechanical difficulty only (not caused by negligent maintenance) you must report to the commissaire in the wheel pit. Re-enter the race as instructed by the commissaires. No free laps will be given in the last 5 laps of the race.

First Aid: Emergency services will be on site. See course map. The nearest hospital is the <u>University of Alberta Hospital</u> (8440 112 St NW). Use 911 in an emergency.

Parking: Community streets around the course.

Washrooms: There will portable toilets near the start finish and there are washrooms at the community hall. NO public urination, you will be disqualified from event.

Food & Drink: Adult race entry includes burger and beer glass. U17/15 and LAMP race entry includes burger. Additional food is available to spectators to support Lendrum Community projects.

Awards: Presentations for each race will be held at the start / finish area during the mustering for the next race. Cash prizes and store gift cards.

ABA Points: This event will be part of the ABA Road Series with series and upgrade points available according to the ABA points schedule B 20, 15, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2

Numerous volunteers work very hard to ensure the race is as safe and enjoyable as possible. Without their help, this event would not be possible. Be sure to follow their instructions, THANK THEM and show them the respect they deserve.
