Technical Information

Region: McLaren Vale

Vineyard: Olivers Seaview Road Vineyard.

Blend: Grenache 70%, Shiraz 20%, Mataro 10%

Alc: 14.0%

Winemaking : All three varieties were eventually co-fermented together but harvested separately. Shiraz came in first, then Grenache added 10 days later and finally the Mataro as whole bunches (to give a lifted Carbonic Maceration character) 14 days after that. As with Ludo, fermentation occurs naturally, there is no added acid, enzymes, tannins or fining agents. The must was basket pressed to old French oak barriques for 10 months maturation.



Tasting Notes

Nose: Medium to full intensity, blackberry morello cherry, thyme and wet hay.

Palate: Medium to full intensity, ripe cherries all the way – round and warm mouth feel. Thyme, peppercorn and rich loam.

Food Match: Slow cooked pork shoulder.
