Elizabeth and Sandra are preparing for their visit to Uganda in October, while there they hope to purchase **2 Treadle Sewing Machines** for use by senior girls at Namadhi. Some girls will be trained to produce reusable sanitary pads to supply the orphanage. Elizabeth and Sandra have planned various activities with the children, as well as talks on Sex Education and Marriage to senior girls. Elizabeth is also able to offer Professional Mentoring to members of staff. Spending time with the House Mothers is a priority as well, to show them just how much they are appreciated for all the care and

Playground Appeal for the Kindergarten Children! Can you Help?



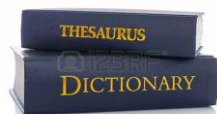
