What to Expect – Elementary

A Warm Welcome

As you and your child arrive at our check-in desk, you will be greeted by a member of our Central Kids Check-In Team. At the check-in desk, you will receive a name tag for your child and a corresponding security tag for yourself. Please indicate any important information that will help in caring for your child, such as allergies or special needs. In addition to the name tag, we ask that you fill out a Central Kids Connection Card. We will upload the information into our database, so you can use an electronic kiosk at your next visit by simply putting in your phone number.

At this age, we strongly encourage that your kid enters the worship service with you. We believe that kids should see his/her parent or guardian engaging in worship. After worship, we will have an hour Small Groups, and you can drop your child off at the Elementary Hallway on the east wing of the church. Your child will be plugged into a class of his/her grade or age group. We hope that you will join a Small Group after your drop your child off.

“The Gospel Project for Kids” is a chronological, Christ-centered Bible study that takes kids through Genesis to Revelation. “The Gospel Project for Kids” delivers engaging Bible teaching, videos, age appropriate music, fun-filled activity sheets and more to help teach your child how God’s plan of redemption unfolds throughout Scripture and is relevant to his/her life. Your kid will gain a clear understanding of the entire gospel story—how all of Scripture points to the gospel of Jesus.

Welcome Time

As you drop your child off, the teacher will greet him/her and make your child feel more comfortable. The teacher will review the previous’ week lesson, and introduce the current week’s lesson by an activity page or game.

Large Group Time

After the teacher introduces the Bible story, all elementary classes will go into our Sparks room for 30 minutes to sing songs, watch the bible story video, discuss the Big Picture Question and Answer and Christ Connection points, and pray. The larger group leader will then dismiss the children back into their small groups.

Small Group Time

In small group time, the class will discuss key passages, main points, participate in activities related to the lesson, and review the Bible story. The class will pray together to end small group time.

Pick-up Procedure

When the time comes to pick up your child, please return to the entrance of the Elementary Hallway and present your security tag to the volunteer standing at the hallway door. The tag will be matched with your child before he/she is released into your care. A child will not be able to leave the room, with a parent, without presentation of the security tag. In the event you lose your security tag, you will be asked to show proper identification before your child may leave with you. We ask that if an older sibling is going to pick up your preschooler that he/she be at least 16 years old.
