



## **MOMENTA – PRO DANZA Interchange Trip**

**23- 31 March 2019 (9 days/8 nights)**

**Meliá Habana Hotel Stay: \$3795 (per person)**

Prices are based on double occupancy and \$450\* round trip commercial flight Chicago/Havana/Chicago  
Single room occupancy is available for an additional cost (see below) — \*airfare prices are subject to change

### **Havana-Land and Air Program Packages Include:**

- Round Trip Commercial Flight with an Airfare: Chicago-HAV-Chicago (based on airfare under \$450)
- Cuban Visa (Note: persons born in Cuba will require additional time, paperwork, and fees to process their Visa)
- US Treasury Department License under The Committee on Illinois to legally travel to Cuba
- Cuba Health Insurance for medical expenses in Cuba beyond a small co-pay
- Group air conditioned bus for all transfers and programs including Roundtrip bus transportation
- Committee on Illinois tour leader
- Bilingual group Cuban tour guide for entire stay
- 8 nights - Double Rooms in Private Homes or selected hotel
- Daily Breakfasts
- Educational Program Sessions (excursions) per itinerary
- Six group dinners, 3 Group lunches (students receive daily lunch during 5 days of classes)
- Program Scheduling and Group Dining Gratuities

### **Not Included:**

- Supplement for Single Room Occupancy (**Additional \$550 for Hotel or \$200 for Private Home Stay**)
- Student Fee for 5-day Dance Intensive (**Additional \$565** based on conversion of \$500 Cuban Convertible Pesos)
- Meals and drinks not specified in final program
