Why do you need a grant from Dosoco?

I am part of an informal singing group in Smallville, Cambridge. This is a rural community and as part of village life we have a group of retired local people who try to gather in the village weekly to sing and socialise. Many of the group are elderly and live alone so this is a good opportunity to meet up, recalling lyrics and learning new tunes also keeps our brains active. We wish to extend the group to include a greater number of people from a wider geographical area. We also want to learn new music and have some music tuition and coaching.

What will the grant be used for?

This funding will enable us to widen the group to include people from the neighbouring villages of Toytown, Tintytown and Little Town. We anticipate that a minimum of 20 people will participate in the group. We propose to provide transport to people from neighbouring villages and those in Smallville who are housebound to be able to participate in a 4 month singing group. We also wish to engage a choir

leader to provide a more structured approach to our singing.

How will the grant help?

It will help to provide access to people who might otherwise not have the opportunity to be part of community singing. The health benefits of singing are well known and we hope this will also lead to reducing isolation for those without access to transport. We also see this as an important part of encouraging community participation across the 4 villages. The grant will help by contributing to the hire of the village hall and to cover the costs to bring a music teacher to our sessions to guide and encourage us. We will also use a small amount to enlarge and then photocopy music and lyric sheets.
