

VANDALIA WERDCC RULES FOR ENTRY

All visitors must present a valid driver's license or state-issued ID with photo. You are not allowed to carry anything into the facility other than your photo ID. Please lock all bags, purses, phones, etc. in your trunk.

SCREENING AND SEARCH

All visitors are subject to electronic monitor screening. Any visitor found in possession of any illegal item or substance will be denied access to the institution and may be referred to law enforcement authorities.

INTERACTION WITH OFFENDERS

Nothing may be given to an offender during a visit to take back to the housing unit.

BEHAVIOR

Visitors may be denied access to the institution for suspected intoxication or use/possession of a controlled substance, profane language, insulting behavior, improper dress, or any behavior which threatens institutional security.

DRESS CODE

Visitors will dress appropriately. The following dress code must be followed:

- A. Clothing must not be excessively tight, see-through or revealing.
- B. Clothing must not be gang-related or camouflaged, and must not have racial slurs, inflammatory language or innapropriate language.
- C. Skirts, dresses and shorts must be no shorter than two inches above the top of the knee cap; no wrap-around skirts/dresses or slit skirts/dresses are permitted.
- D. Slacks/jeans - no holes or slits permitted. No bib overalls.
- E. Shirts, blouses, dress tops must cover the shoulders, chest and stomach. Display of cleavage, midriff or back is not permitted.
- F. Appropriate undergarments must be worn.
- G. Shoes must be worn except for infants not walking. Shoes with any type of compartments will not be allowed.
- H. Jewelry will be limited to one (1) necklace, two (2) rings, one (1) pair of earrings and one (1) watch.
- I. Headgear will only be worn based on religious requirements. Such headgear will be subject to search.

Visitors will be offered alternative apparel to put on over their clothing if they are not appropriately dressed so as to qualify for the visit. If visitors decline to use the apparel, they will not be permitted to visit until appropriately attired.

MEDICATIONS AND MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

Medications and medical equipment needed to maintain the visitor's life (such as nitroglycerine, insulin, oxygen or asthma inhaler) may be retained on the person of the visitor.

1. The visitor must inform the visiting room officer of the need for the medication/medical equipment.
2. Visitors who have surgically implanted metal hardware must submit a written statement from a physician.
3. Visitors who have special needs, i.e., wheelchairs, assistance animals, etc., must submit a written statement from a physician. Notice should be made in advance of the visit so any special arrangements to assist the visitor can be made.
4. The visiting room officers will insure that syringes and needles are secured in the visitor's locker. Visitors will be escorted from the visiting room for medication purposes and then escorted back.

Necessary prosthetic devices are also permitted.

All items are subject to search upon entry and exit of the institution.
