

Accommodations at the market

1. Traders

The table below shows 43 traders.

- The take away food items should be around or close to the seating area but must be careful not to create too much congestion – especially relevant for the pancake stand with its long queues.
- Sealed food includes olives, biscuits and pestos – typically things that can be thrown into a bag and taken home. Doesn't necessarily have to be in particular area.
- Pets refers to the Animal Welfare stall. They sometimes display pups and kittens in cages for display. NOT food compatible
- Plants and veg. These are very useful as a colourful display and works well in a prominent space. Eg large trestle at the entrance welcoming one in.
- Info refers to the GCS stand which sells postcards but also acts as the 'office' from where money is collected and various minor admin happens. Should be visually distinctive/stand alone.
- Books from the Red Cross book stall. In the temporary market the large trestle works very well as an island that people can browse around. It also breaks the central area well. This stand should be built to allow for lock up of books.

2. Stall spaces

The table below shows the number of stall spaces required. Each stall space is 1.5m long.

Formal refers to normal stands under roof with table. Custom refers to informal stall space that a trader will occupy catering for his own needs. Ideally we should supply these traders with shade as well but can be less formal. This space or spaces allow for the expansion and contraction of the market. A new trader will start in an informal space and then in time as a formal spot becomes available they will move there – if it is suitable. Some traders come with their own tables and chairs or custom made carts and lend a casual atmosphere to the market.
