As a result, we are in the process of ongoing recruiting for the position of **Contract Inspector**.

Responsibilities include:

Performing pole and/or line inspections of existing electrical infrastructure in order to document the attachments (electrical, cable, communication, etc.) that are on the pole. The information is gathered by visual inspection and input utilizing a tablet based application and GPS for pole location. Inspectors travel to pole location via truck, ATV or on foot. Inspectors work closely with employees from local electrical utilities for specific information per project. Inspectors regularly interface with local electrical customers. Inspectors must have pro-active communication skills in order to ask questions and clarify expectations to assure the accuracy of their inspections.

Required Skills include:

- Knowledge of pole-top assemblies and general distribution construction and ability to read and interpret electric utility maps is preferred.
- Familiarity and comfort with the use of a tablet computer, such as an iPad or Android device. Technology skills are required. Experience with GPS equipment or GIS mapping software is a plus.
- Strong cooperation and communication skills and a positive attitude.
- Interpersonal skills to work with electric utility employees and willing to following their lead.
- Strong customer service attitude in dealing peacefully and positively with property owners.
- Trustworthiness and ability to working independently and stay on task.

Physical Requirements:

- Willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Physically able to complete the tasks associated with the job.

#### Additional Requirements and Considerations:

- Valid driver's license
- Ability to pass a drug test.
- Willing to travel.

#### Compensation

The position pays an hourly rate including transportation time. Contract Inspectors are generally expected to furnish their own transportation. Lodging, mileage, and meals will be reimbursed.

Previous utility experience will be given additional consideration. Additional consideration will also be given for military service.
