A Message from: Sister Mary Alyce

I was heartened to see that the Mass attendance on Labor Day weekend was over 500. As I commented in the past, your presence at liturgy is very important to the community. I have no idea what past numbers have been, but I LOVE to see the attendance going up.

Recently, Pope Francis, in a major address for National Liturgical Week in August, spoke of his desire to continue the renewal of liturgy as promulgated by Vatican II more than 50 years ago. (Who ever said that changes in the Church happen fast?) As he reviewed the progress, Pope Francis highlighted few areas of this renewal.

First, he clearly affirms the importance of active participation in the liturgy, a participation that rejects participants assisting as "strangers and silent spectators" ("Sacrosanctum Concilium, No.48"). (√ St. Luke)

Second, he espouses the council's own careful balance between respect of healthy tradition and legitimate progress (No. 23). (√ St. Luke)

Third, he reiterates the necessity of long-term and patient liturgical education for both pastors and people. (√ St. Luke)

Fourth, he speaks of the liturgy as the living presence of Christ, a presence that is manifested in multiple ways: the Eucharistic elements, the priest himself, the word proclaimed and the assembly gathered (No. 7). Francis' emphasis on the multiple modes of the presence of Christ in the liturgy is particularly important because it leads him to say that the altar is "the center toward which our attention converges...the gaze of the praying people, priest and faithful, is oriented to the altar, *convoked for the assembly around it*. (√ St. Luke)

Finally, and certainly consistent with the fourth emphasis, is Francis' insistence that the liturgy is an action ("*for the people, but also of the people*"). He refers to his own homilies to drive home the insight that liturgy is not so much about doctrine in some abstract sense but about putting Christian life into action. The Eucharist in particular is not so much an act of private piety as it is the formation of the people of God. (√ St. Luke)

I feel blessed to follow in the footsteps of your past pastors/associate pastors/liturgists who heeded Vatican II reforms and moved St. Luke Parish to where it is today. Thank you for moving with the Universal Church here in Boardman.

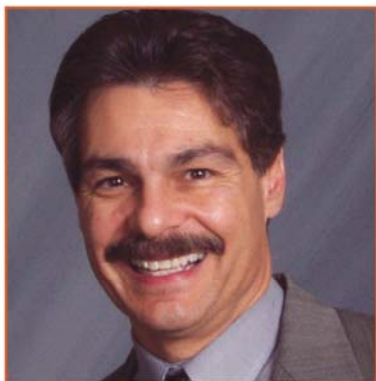

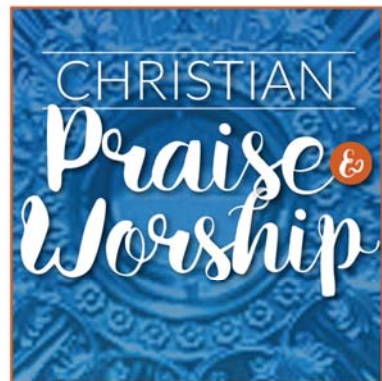
