In October it will be 50 years since the 1967 Abortion Act was passed. That anniversary will be marked in various ways. For those who have had an abortion, this anniversary year is a reminder that 50 years on: "there is no sin that God's mercy cannot reach and wipe away when it finds a repentant heart seeking to be reconciled with the Father" (Pope Francis, Apostolic Letter, *Misericordia et misera*, 12).
