ST CATHERINE'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL

We always have very exciting days at St. Catherine's but this week has been extra special. On Monday, Class 2 had an incubator with 10 eggs delivered to school; by 7:45am on Wednesday morning the staff were standing transfixed as three of the eggs had hatched! When the chicks were warm and fluffy, they were transferred into a large heated box with food and water, which allowed the children to observe them closely. This has been a unique way of introducing the concept of life and death as it prompted the discussion of, 'What if the egg doesn't hatch?'. During the month of November, when we pray for those who have died, it is important to find ways for the children to express themselves. Y5 and Y6 have also explored this theme through a very different way, researching the traditions of the 'Day of the Dead.' Their classroom has been adorned in beautiful twinkling lights and colourfully decorated paper skulls! Y3 and Y4 represented St. Catherine's at the Remembrance Service in St. Andrew's Churchyard and followed this with a wonderful assembly for the whole school on Friday.
