

Just Dance Fitness Training Ltd (trading as 'Just Dance UK') Terms and Conditions

Please read the Just Dance UK Terms and Conditions carefully prior to booking all classes, parties, events and first dance tuition. Just Dance UK cannot afterwards be held responsible for any errors caused by failure to read or understand them in full. The terms and conditions will differ slightly for each different type of event. Please ensure that you have read the relevant section relating to the activity you are undertaking.

Just Dance UK Party Bookings

The minimum number for a hen/party booking is 10 people (smaller groups will be charged at the same rate as 10 people).

A deposit is required to secure all bookings and preferred venues will not be booked until a deposit payment has been received. This deposit is non-refundable.

Full outstanding balance, confirmation of music choices, party themes and number of participants are required 14 days prior to the event. Once final details have been confirmed and the full balance paid, the balance is non-refundable.

All session times include changing, filling out an activity disclaimer, warm up and cool down. Any medical conditions/pregnancy should be addressed before any event or class due to the physical nature of this exercise. Participants take part at their own risk and everyone is required to sign a disclaimer.

It is the group's responsibility to arrive for their activity on time as the finishing time cannot be extended.

In the event that the Just Dance UK team hire a venue/studio on behalf of the client, if the client and/or guests damage any of the property within the venue, the client agrees to pay for any damage caused in full.

Age Stipulation

Participants must all be over 18 if their party is held in a bar. If, within any group bookings, there are found to be prospective participants who are under this age, we reserve the right to request their removal from the party.

Alterations

Occasionally due to circumstances beyond our control, we must reserve the right to change the start times, dates, or venue locations previously established for your parties and first dance tuition. Where we cannot meet your needs, we will offer a full refund.

Material

We occasionally use stills and footage of our dance experiences and courses for marketing purposes. In taking part, participants agree to grant us royalty-free, non-exclusive license to publish and otherwise use the material in any media worldwide.

First Dance

Full payment is required to secure the booking a minimum of 14 days prior to the date of the first lesson. A minimum of 48 hours notice prior to lesson commencement is required by the couple to cancel/re-schedule a lesson. All payments are non-refundable.

Just Dance UK do not refund payment if the client decides not to continue the lessons half way through the booking for no other reason or if the wedding is cancelled.

Liability

Just Dance UK take all reasonable steps to ensure a safe experience and environment for all participants and holds appropriate public liability insurance.

All activities are undertaken at the participants' own risk and Just Dance UK cannot be responsible for claims of injury, damage or loss.

Participants should ensure they have adequate insurance to cover any activity they undertake.

Health and Safety

All those taking part in first dance lessons and Just Dance UK parties are required to sign an activity disclaimer. All first dance lessons and Just Dance UK party participants must warrant that they are fit to undertake the first dance/party activity and advise the instructor of any medical conditions that may affect them. Furthermore, you must at all times follow the instructions issued by our teachers, who are trained to be mindful of your health and safety at all times. Any failure to follow instruction will automatically invalidate your insurance in the event of any injury you sustain as a consequence of this failure. Similarly, failure to follow the advice of your own GP will also render your insurance invalid for the purpose of claims.

Just Dance UK Privacy Policy

Just Dance UK is committed to the protection of your personal information in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998 and the EU GDPR Privacy and data policies.

When you make a booking with Just Dance UK we record your name, e-mail address and telephone number. Your telephone number and e-mail address will not be passed on to any third party and we will only use your number/e-mail address to contact you regarding your booking and Just Dance UK specific activities.

Indemnity

You agree that Just Dance UK, and its freelance choreographers, partners and employees, will not be liable to you for any claim or demand, including reasonable solicitors' fees, due to or arising from your first dance tuition / Just Dance UK party or event.

Termination

Just Dance UK may terminate this Agreement immediately if the Clients are found to be in breach of contract.

Just Dance UK may terminate this Agreement by giving 24 hours notice.

Just Dance UK Clients may terminate this Agreement at any time but forfeit any deposit or booking payments made in accordance with the relevant activity cancellation policies as set out in this Agreement.

This Agreement sets out all of the terms between Just Dance UK and the Clients.

This contract shall be governed in accordance with the laws of England and English Courts shall have jurisdiction in relation to the Agreement.

Class Memberships

10 Class Pass - £90 for 10 Just Dance UK classes

This pack allows you to purchase a block of 10 classes for the reduced rate of £90 (saving £10.00/one class free). By purchasing this pack you are entitled to attend any 10 hour-long Zumba, Dance or Flowetic classes from the current Just Dance UK timetable. If you would like to attend a yoga (£12) or Tone & Stretch (£5) class, you can book and pay extra for these classes on top of your 10 class pass. All class passes are valid for a 12 month period.

Classes must be booked in advance through our website timetable or Just Dance UK app. If a class you want to attend is full at the time of booking, you can be placed on our waiting list which will notify you if we receive a cancellation for that class. This will then allow you to book your place onto that class if still desired.

Booking works on a first come first served basis and we are unable to hold places open without a formal booking. If you are unable to attend a class, you can cancel up to 1 hour before the class starts. If cancelled within this time you will receive a class credit back to your account. If you fail to attend a class you have booked without cancelling within the 1 hour timeframe, you will lose your class credit for that class.

Once you have used all of the credits for this class pass you will be required to either purchase another type of membership or continue as a Pay As You Go customer.

Monthly Pass - £60 for a month of unlimited Just Dance UK classes

This membership allows you to attend unlimited classes for a payment of £60.00 per calendar month. Your monthly membership starts on the date of purchase and expires one calendar month later (for example, if you purchase a monthly pass on 9th April, it will expire on 9th May) irrespective of any public bank holidays included within that time frame. Any scheduled Just Dance holidays will always be taken into account to ensure you always receive a full month of classes.

By purchasing this membership you are entitled to attend any classes from the current Just Dance UK timetable. You will receive an automated email to let you know when your monthly membership expires.

Classes must be booked in advance through the Just Dance UK website timetable or GloFox app. If a class you wish to attend is full at the time of booking, you can be placed on our waiting list which will notify you if we receive a cancellation for that class. This will allow you to book your place onto that class if you'd like.

Booking works on a first come first served basis and we are unable to hold places open without a formal booking. If you are unable to attend a class you can cancel the class up to 1 hour before the class starts.

Rolling Monthly Sub- £60 each month for unlimited Just Dance UK classes

For the dedicated Just Dancer, our monthly rolling subscription allows you to access unlimited classes for an ongoing recurring payment of £60 per calendar month. There's no need to renew each month, the payment will automatically be taken from your account. Payments will come out on the date of purchase and on that same date each following month.

Unlike the one off monthly membership, this rolling subscription allows you to pause your membership. If you would like to pause your membership, please contact info@justdanceuk.com with as much notice as you can detailing the reason and duration you would like to pause your subscription for. Upon re-subscribing, your next payment date will be extended by the number of days the membership is paused for.

Best of all, if you select this option, irrespective of when price increases happen, the price at which you buy your membership remains fixed to you forever! The only exception to this would be in the event that you choose to cancel your membership completely, you would then need to repurchase your subscription at the current advertised rate.

By purchasing this membership you are entitled to attend any classes from the current Just Dance UK timetable. Classes must be booked in advance through the timetable on the Just Dance UK website (www.justdanceuk.com) or via the app.

If a class you wish to attend is full at the time of booking, you can be placed on our waiting list which will notify you if we receive a cancellation for that class. This will allow you to book your place onto that class if still desired. Booking works on a first come first served basis and we are unable to hold places open without a formal booking.
