

## CROSSING THE BORDER

All travelers, including children, require a passport or state enhanced driver's license for all modes of transportation in and out of the US. (land, sea, rail, air). We highly recommend getting your passport TODAY. Note: a past criminal history, including DUI, could cause problems when entering Canada. For advice contact the Canadian Border Agency at [www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/index.asp](http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/index.asp) for up to date information. If you have a child in your group who is crossing without both parents we recommend a letter of permission from the missing parent.

## DUTY FREE

When crossing into Canada you are able to bring a specific amount of tobacco and alcohol if you are the correct legal age. You are able to bring 200 cigarettes; 50 cigars; 200 grams (7 oz.) of manufactured tobacco; AND 200 tobacco sticks. For alcohol you can have 50 oz. of wine; OR a total of 40 oz. of alcoholic beverages; OR up to 287 oz. of beer or ale.

## TAXES

All rates and packages are subject to 13% HST tax (harmonized sales tax). ## CHECK IN/CHECK OUT

Check in begins on Friday after 1:00 pm. Fishing and hunting licenses must be obtained prior to coming to camp. Once you have made it to the Red Lake area we ask that all groups call the office at 647-478-2904 to inform us of your arrival time. Most Cell phone coverage ends around Balmertown. If there is no answer please leave a message with time called. If there is no one at the landing when you get there, we are taking another group in and will be right back for you. There are no boats out on Friday.

Check out begins at 5:00 am the following Friday. Guests find it convenient to pay their bill before 8:00 pm the evening prior to departure as this saves time and eliminates lengthy waiting periods in the morning.

## PET FRIENDLY

Pets are more than welcome to join their owners at Nungesser Lake Lodge, as long as they are kept on a leash and are well behaved. You are responsible for any damage done by your pet. When bringing a pet over three months of age into Canada you must have a valid rabies vaccination certificate.

## ALCOHOL

The legal age to consume alcohol in Ontario is 19. Please note: It is illegal to consume any alcoholic beverages while on the water. Those who take alcohol in their boats risk being fined by the Provincial Police. We do not allow our guides to drink on the job and we ask that guests not encourage this. Guests are responsible for their own fines.

We encourage staff to mix freely with guests but under no circumstances are they allowed to drink alcohol on resort property. Staff members are not allowed into guests cabins at any time except in the normal course of their duties.

## WEATHER

Summer days are generally warm with cooler temperatures in the evening, but you must be prepared for all types of weather. Light clothing is essential, but a sweatshirt and long pants that you can layer, rain gear and a comfortable pair of shoes are a good idea. Don't forget your bathing suit.

## WI-FI FRIENDLY

For the business traveller, each cabin has a wireless connection. There is a lap top computer available for your use in the TV room. This service is free of charge. Cell phones will not work in camp and a satellite phone is available for use up at the house.

## BEAR HUNTING

We have land access as well as water only access sites available. Expect a successful hunt as we take only a limited number of hunters per year. All sites are pre-baited ahead of time and maintained throughout your hunt. All hunters will be placed on the sites in early afternoon and picked up just after dark. We have our tree stands set up for bow, rifle or shot gun hunts. Freezer storage is available for hide and meat.

It is necessary for every hunter to provide a copy of their current hunting license.
