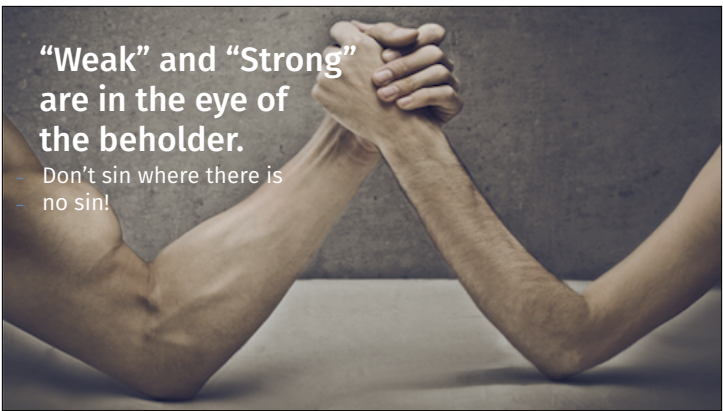




Christian Unity Is Intentional

“Weak” and “Strong” are in the eye of the beholder.

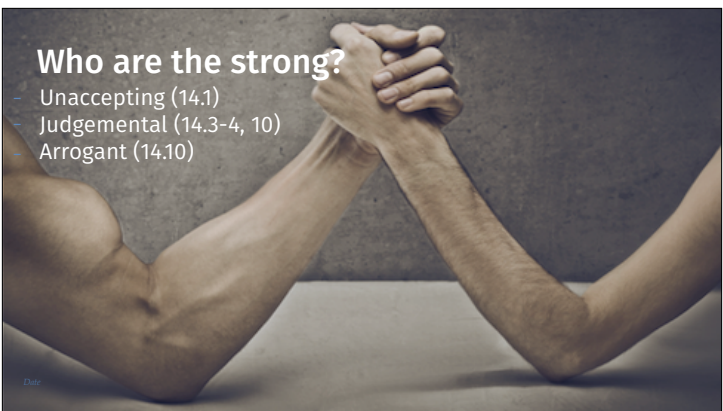
- Don't sin where there is no sin!

(Romans 14.4-6)



Who are the strong?


- Unaccepting (14.1)

Unity is based upon a welcoming heart

- God has welcomed us (14.3)
- Jesus is Master of the house (14.4)
- In the End it won't matter (14.4)



A servant is not above his Master...

- No disciple is above his teacher, no slave above his master. 25 It is enough for the disciple that he become like his teacher, for the slave that he become like his master. (Matthew 10.24)
