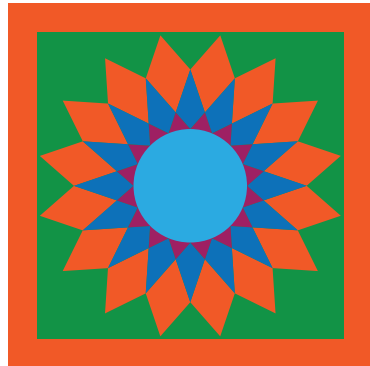
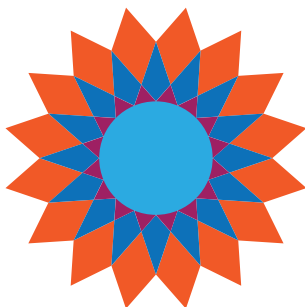


Colorful Sunflower Garden Pillow

(Uses 16" Pillow Form)







Compass Cutting





***All strips cut from full width of fabric and based on 42" fabric width.**









10" Sunflower

-  2 strips x 2 1/2"
-  2 strips x 2"
-  1 strip x 1 1/2"
-  5" square - circle template included with **Original Fat Robin 60° Mariner's Compass Ruler/Book**

Pillow Parts Cutting

-  2 strips x 2" x 16 1/2"
-  2 strips x 2" x 19 1/2"
-  2 rectangles x 14" x 19 1/2"
-  1 Square 16 1/2"

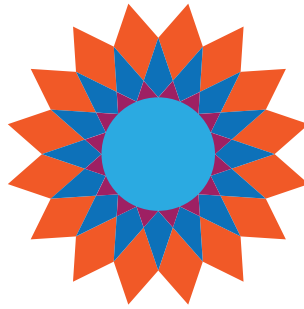
Total Yardage

-  Pillow Border and Back
1/2 yd.
-  Pillow Background
16 1/2" square - 1/2 yd.
-  Background Strips
2 strips x 2 1/2"=5" - 1/4 yd.
-  Point 1 Strips
2 strips x 2" = 4" - 1/8 yd.
-  Inside Point 3 Strip
1 strip x 1 1/2" - 1/8 yd.
-  Center
5" square

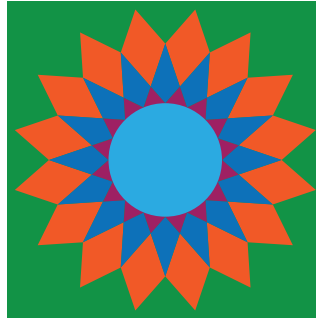

Construction

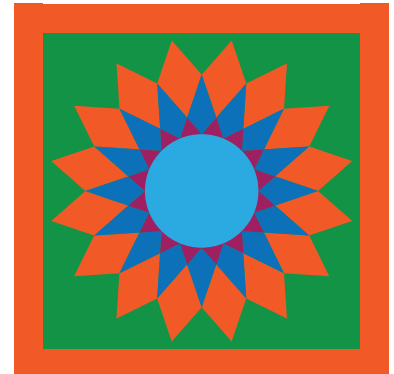
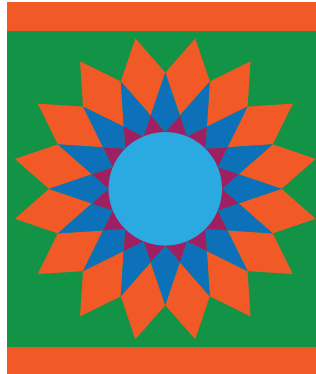
- 1 Make 10" Sunflower. Applique center. I raw edge applique the center in my sample. Follow **Original Fat Robin Mariner's Compass Book** instructions for using the provided center templates.



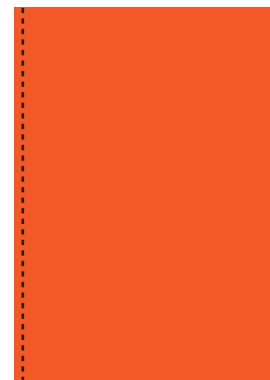
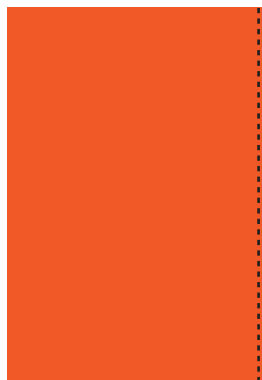
- 2 Center and raw edge applique Sunflower block onto background square. Baste or use spray baste to secure block to background before raw edge appliqueing.



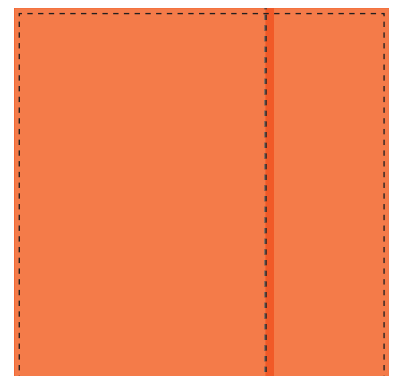
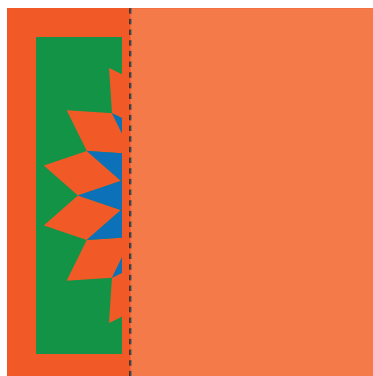
- 3 Add borders. Add the shorter borders first on the top and bottom, and then the longer borders on the sides.



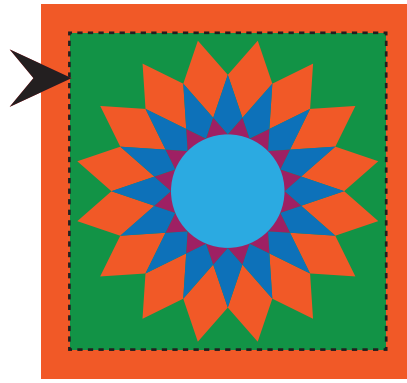
- 4 Finish long edges of pillow back units. Press edge under 1/4" and then press under again. Top-stitch approximately 1/4" from finished edge making sure to catch all fabric on back side.



- 5 Sew pillow back units to Sunflower Block. Lay right pillow back, right side down, onto block and then lay left pillow back, right side down, onto block. Sew 1/4" seam around entire pillow perimeter.



- 6 Trim corners and turn pillow cover right side out. Stitch in the ditch between pillow border and block background. Reinforce by backstitching where pillow backs overlap.



- 7 Insert 16" Pillow Form and enjoy!
