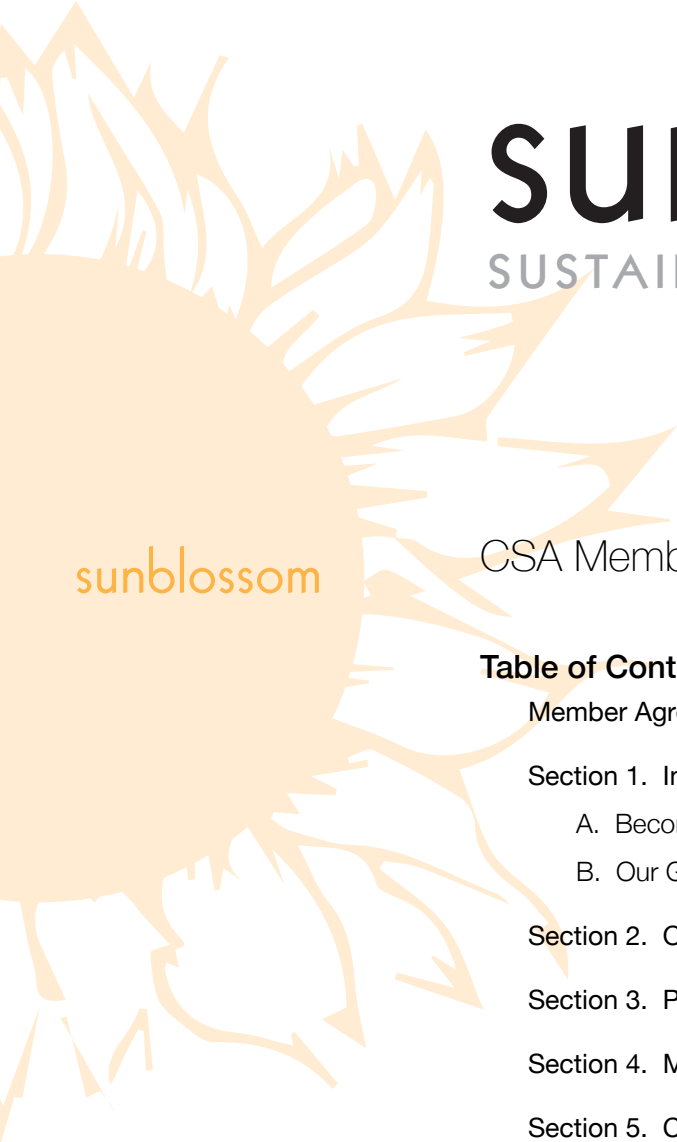

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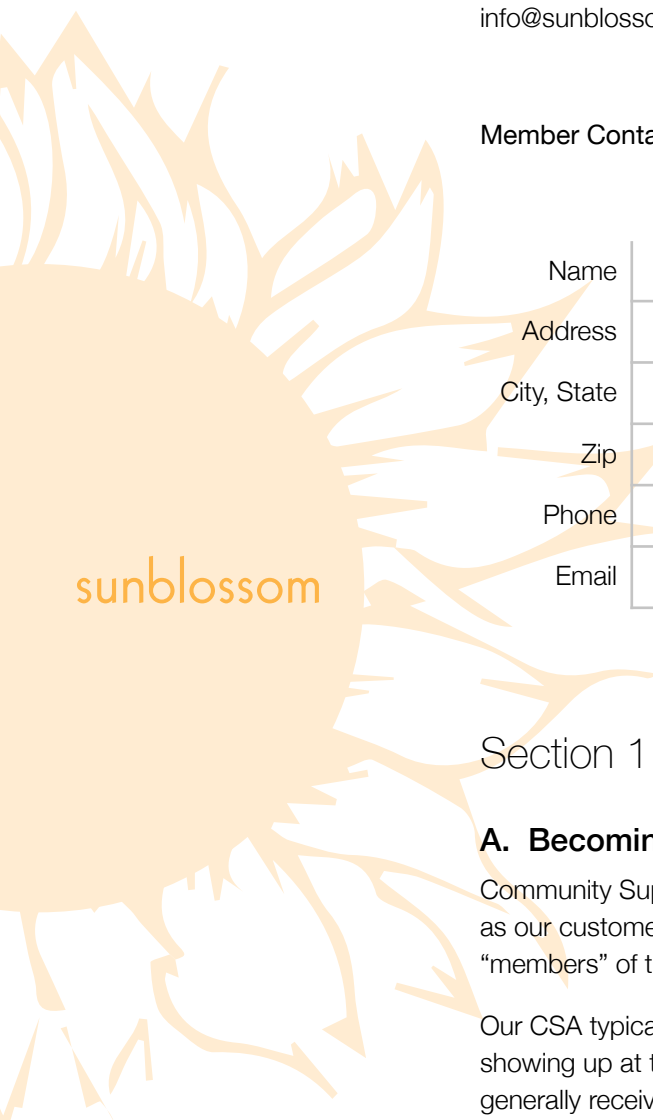
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## Member Agreement for 2017

**Section 1. Introducing Our CSA Farm**

**A. Becoming a Part of Our Farm**

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a relationship between our farm and you as our customer. Rather than simply purchasing flowers, our customers become “members” of this CSA farm who receive a portion of the farm’s harvest.

Our CSA typically runs from June through September. Members are responsible for showing up at the farm to pick up your share of freshly harvested flowers. You will generally receive one large bouquet of cut flowers, or for U-Pick memberships, access to harvest as many flower as you can fit in our provided bouquet size container. Detailed information regarding pick-up is discussed below in Section 3. Variety and quantity may vary as described below in Section 2.

**B. Our Growing Practices**

The farm is not currently certified, however we follow organic practices. Our flowers are grown without using conventional pesticides, herbicides or synthetic fertilizers

made with synthetic ingredients. For more information, please ask. We'd be happy to tell you more.

## Section 2. Our Shared Commitments

We promise to do our best to provide you with a bountiful share each week. The quantity of flowers, however, may vary from week-to-week due to extreme weather, insects, or other production factors despite our best efforts. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share the risk of crop failure with us and other members. In the unlikely event of a crop failure, we may not be able to deliver any product in some weeks.

## Section 3. Picking Up Shares

You are responsible for picking up your share each week from the farm. Pick up times are: Saturdays from 11:00am to 1:00pm.

If you cannot pick-up your share, you must arrange for someone else to pick it up for you. You are responsible for explaining the pick-up location and procedures to your substitute. Shares that are not retrieved within the pick-up time will be sold or donated.

## Section 4. Member Fees

By selling membership in advance of the growing season, CSA reduces the burden of up-front costs for the farmer. Your membership fees provide us with money to purchase seed and equipment before the season starts, and we appreciate your commitment. Place a check mark next to the share type you would like from the list below.

The CSA runs 10 weeks, June 3rd through October 7th, 2017, with pickup every *other* Saturday from 11am to 1:00pm.

By submitting an agreement form you are agreeing to pay the membership fee for the share you indicated above.

All payments are non-refundable beyond the fourth week of the season.

## Section 5. Communicating with Us

We will do our best to respond as soon as possible, but please understand that we spend most of our time in the field growing your flowers and not at our desk. Please contact us with any news of the following: changes to your postal or email address, or dissatisfaction with your share.

We will communicate with you by email. When you sign up, you will be added to our distribution list. Please read your email from us. We depend on being able to communicate important information such as necessary changes to your distribution schedule or to our farm events.
