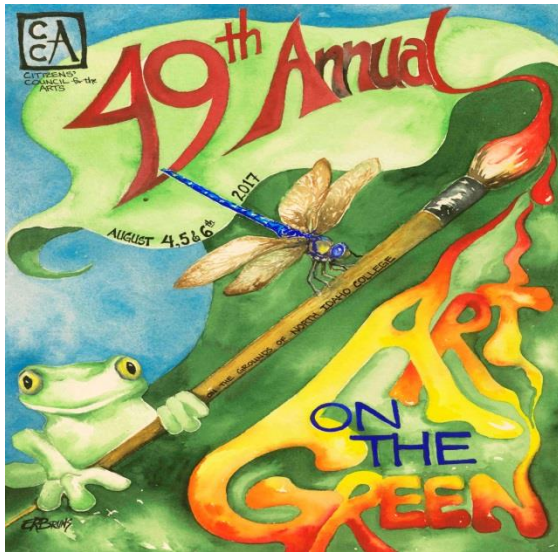


## 2017 ART ON THE GREEN POSTER
