Broad Art Museum (at left)
Michigan State University - East Lansing, MI
30,000 sqft, \$30 million, Art Museum
Designed by Pritzker award winning architect Zaha Hadid, this concrete and pleated steel museum is the recipient of national honors from the American Institute of Steel Construction and the Concrete Reinforcing Steel Institute.

Kruizenga Art Museum
Hope College, Holland, Michigan
15,000 sqft, \$5 million Art Museum
Conceived to stand out as a distinctive presence on a small campus the Kruizenga Museum serves its community as an exhibit Gallery and teaching space. The steel and concrete structure defines galleries with vertical fins.

MOCAD
Midtown Detroit - Detroit, Michigan
22,000 sqft, Art Studio
The Museum of Contemporary Art Detroit appropriately inhabits an historic midtown auto dealership. The raw structure enclose galleries serving as a progressive cultural beacon in the re-emerging city.

Crankbrook Academy Studios
Cranbrook Academy - Bloomfield Hills, MI
22,000 sqft, \$9 million Studio Space
Studio space for programs in ceramics, arts, and metalworking, designed by Rafael Moneo. This addition to the iconic Eiel Saarinan Museum is one of dozens of structures SDI has been entrusted with on the Cranbrook Campus.

School of Music Theater and Dance
University of Michigan - Ann Arbor, Michigan
34,000 sqft, \$29 million addition & renovation
Steel framed addition to the Eero Saarinen designed music school provides acoustically separated practice rooms, rehearsal halls, and lecture halls, for this premier music education program.
