Broadside Cabernet Sauvignon is a yearly expression of that noble grape in Paso Robles' sun and soils. Printers Alley is the counterpoint, enabling our winemakers' instincts to explore the highlights of a given vintage to create the most enjoyable blend possible. To that end, we employ the same restrained techniques in the cellar, leaving fruit at the forefront in an approachable, user-friendly style. The 2013 utilizes small lots of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, along with Petit Verdot to produce a youthfully fresh and easy drinking Bordeaux-inspired red.

Seamless plum, berry, tamarind and spice aromas highlight this medium weight, juicy fruit-driven blend.

45% Cabernet Sauvignon
50% Merlot
5% Petit Verdot

Barrel - French & American oak -
5% new

Fermentation - Native with no additions or adjustments in the cellar
