Broadside Cabernet Sauvignon is the result of our faithful effort to capture a pure and unadulterated representation of the grape and site. With 1000 feet of elevation and a chilling coastal influence, the well-drained soils at Margarita Vineyard provide a balance of stress and sustenance to the rugged vines.

Their fruit is marked by small berries, concentrated flavors, and fine tannins. While robustly fruited in its youth, Broadside Cabernet Sauvignon is graced with an underlying framework of subtle tannin and acidity that ensures a bright future in the cellar as well.

Abundant Paso Robles sunshine in 2013 led to our most expressive and opulent vintage yet. Inky ruby, with notes of black currant, cigar box spice, and plum. It's substantial structure and lengthy finish ensure a long life ahead.
