

## Safety Net Plan - Example

This plan is implemented to make sure that this child and classmates are safe in the classroom. It will be used in response to extreme behaviors that jeopardize his safety and the safety of others. It is used in conjunction with his child support plan. All staff members who use these procedures must also be implementing his child support plan.

### Safety Net Plan

#### When the child:

Tantrums by jumping up and down, grunting loudly, throws objects, hits or kicks other children or teachers.

#### The teachers or support providers will:

1. Keep all children safe by moving them away from harm.
2. If possible, guide J. to quiet place (chill out place?)
3. Stand near J. without any physical contact until he is calm, (grunting noises stop and body and breathing is calm)
4. Once he is calm, talk to J. about the expected behavior, i.e. using words to express "big feelings" or get things you need or asking a teacher for help.
5. Return to the room or outside area with J. and shadow him on re-entry for the next 10 minutes to ensure the episode is over.
6. If needed, create zones where staff shadow J. for the day
7. Document the event in log.
