3. Applications must be submitted in English and should contain no more than 1,000 words excluding your name, contact information and institution (Font: Times New Roman, Size 12 point) and a maximum of 10 pages including support documents.

- C. List and describe your results.
- D. Tell us how being a scholarship recipient will benefit you relative to this project.

7. Award Notification

- 1) Everyone will be notified by May 30, 2014 of the results.
- 2) The Recipients of the 2014 Eve Hall Memorial LMI Scholarship will be asked to provide a presentation on their winning application to the general audience at the LMI International Conference on Workforce Management.
