WILDING PINE PROGRAMME REPORT

2015-16 PROGRAMME

The following work has been completed since May.

QUEEN CHARLOTTE SOUND

Anathia

Felling of the trees at the Bowdler bach was undertaken in mid-May, with a few missed trees on the inner side of the peninsula treated at the same time.

Furneaux Head

Felling of the trees around the powerlines at Miner's Wharf was undertaken in mid-May, with the Rhodes family once again providing accommodation.

Some trees further up the valley were left while Marlborough Lines determines the status of a low voltage powerline and whether we can fell or poison these trees. Some funds have been carried forward to allow for this.

We also treated a few missed trees above The Pines while on site.

DI Maintenance

Two days were spent treating trees around Kapowai, which had partly been controlled by the landowner in the past. This work was funded through a donation from the landowner.



Otuatangi Bay

Further time was put in tidying up the stand of large trees at Otuatangi Bay, which we had boom-sprayed as a trial two years ago.
