

Update to Pot Melt Tutorial



I have done hundreds of pot melts since I wrote the tutorial and I am still enjoying them as much as ever. The only 2 things I am doing differently now is :

1. I am almost always dripping onto a single or double sheet of glass that sits on a full sheet of thin fire. The glass does not move so much that it is a problem because this base glass holds it in place. The clean up is much easier.

2. I am spraying the 1/8" fiber paper that goes inside the stainless steel with MR97. With the spray the glass slides down the fiber much easier and there is little to no spiking. This is especially a good idea if you do not have cold working equipment!! After cutting the length of the paper I take it outside, hold one end of it and spray a quick spray top to bottom.

If you do not want white fingers wear throw away gloves on that hand!

If you are loving pot melts be sure to try one of our annulars. You will love them too for a different look!!
