## Technology / Personal devices Usage Agreement

---

Sunnydale Adventist Academy believes that technology enhances academic achievement. Therefore, Sunnydale provides networked computers with Internet access, individual server storage space for files, e-mail accounts, and access to printers. The use of the school computer network is a privilege that each student must protect.

The primary use of computer/electronic devices (hereafter referred to as “technology”) at Sunnydale is for educational purposes. Each student is responsible for understanding what appropriate use of computer/electronic devices is and if in doubt, they should ask the network administrator.

The following guidelines will assist the students in understanding what appropriate technology use is:

- The primary use of technology is for educational value.
- The secondary use of technology is for communication with family.
- Technology is **not** to be used to send or display offensive material.
- Individuals are **not** to tamper with computer equipment. This includes, yet is not limited to: changing of equipment settings, downloading without permission, installing a program, using another student’s password, sharing a password, disconnecting equipment, or moving equipment.
- On-line dating websites and apps are not to be used.
- Students are not to connect personal devices to the school network, except by the guest wireless network.
- Students are not to set up any type of a computer network or personal hotspot without administrative permission.

Violating the appropriate use of technology at Sunnydale will result in restricted use, the loss of technology privileges, or dismissal from school. The administration of Sunnydale reserves the right to view all emails, personal files, network activity, and communications that resides on or is transmitted from personal or school devices.
