The Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science is accepting applications for a faculty position in Visual Arts for the 2018-19 academic year. The successful candidate will be prepared to teach a range of visual arts courses. Because of the unique nature of MSMS and its mission, all faculty and staff members are expected to provide state and national leadership in their respective areas of expertise.

The Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science is a public, residential high school for academically gifted and talented eleventh and twelfth grade students located on the campus of the Mississippi University for Women, Columbus, Mississippi. The mission is "to enhance the future of Mississippi in the global society by 1)meeting the individual needs of gifted and talented students through providing innovative learning experiences and leadership development in a residential environment, 2)providing quality educational leadership for other educators, and 3)conducting aggressive outreach programs that impact students across Mississippi." MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

1. Master's Degree or above in the related field. A terminal degree in the field is preferred.
2. Five years of teaching experience at the secondary or post-secondary level. A valid Mississippi teaching license (endorsement 102) is desirable.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

1. Salary is based upon the established position scale. Beginning salary ranges are from \$54,587 to \$57,859.
2. The position is contracted for 190 days.
3. Reporting date will be on or near August 1, 2018.

Applications will be accepted until the position is filled. All applications will be acknowledged but only selected candidates will be interviewed. Application review will begin the week **of March 19, 2018**.
