The Ottomans were excellent seaman, their ships and captains known all over the Mediterranean Sea. Our Gemi - or ship - tile is an homage to Ottoman naval prowess and depicts a kalyon - galleon - at full sail on the open seas. In cheery red and blues.

Accent tiles do not create repeating designs, and are excellent as accents in kitchen backsplashes, interspersed on bathroom walls, etc.

Iznik tiles are one of the most recognizable of all Ottoman arts. The iconic tiles are named after their production center in Iznik – ancient Nicaea, of the Nicaean Code – which lies on the eastern shore of the Marmara Sea.

The height of Iznik tiles in both design and technique was the 16th century, during the height of the Ottoman Empire. Our handmade tiles maintain this artistic legacy and support contemporary artisans in Turkey.

Handmade in Turkey

Underglazed, hand painted ceramic tiles

Iznik tiles are for wall and accent use. Suitable for use in wet areas such as bathrooms and kitchens. Not for use as flooring. Small cracks in the glaze, minor variations in color, and small slips of the brush are hallmarks of the process and are not flaws.

Tiles are made to order and ship directly from Turkey
