ProdecoTech Renews Gold Sponsorship for 2014**

ProdecoTech moved into their 60,000 square foot state of the art facility in June of 2013. There, they produce 22 different models of e-bikes under the following names: the Phantom, the Mariner, the Storm, the Oasis, the Outlaw, the Genesis, the Stride, and the Titanio and even more models are planned for release in 2014. Each is built for a different kind of riding experience.

ProdecoTech bikes are considerably lighter than most in the industry, and they fold for easy transport and storage. All incorporate durable and lightweight lithium ion phosphate batteries, with five of the models weighing only 42-46 pounds (including batteries) which are considerably lighter than the industry norm. Models utilize double or triplewall aluminum rims, 12G stainless steel spokes, high-performance braking systems, and commercial grade frames.

While many high quality electric bikes cost over \$2,000, ProdecoTech's ebikes start at \$1,099. Rather than the usual one-year warranty on batteries and components, ProdecoTech has a minimum two-year warranty and a lifetime warranty for the frame. ProdecoTech's goal is to change the way the world looks at electric bikes, and to make American built electric bikes a part of everyone's lifestyle. They plan to help LEVA achieve its goals as well.
