## HOOD RIVER PHOTOGRAPHER TAKES PART IN HISTORIC STATEWIDE PROJECT

July 8, 2013 – On July 15, 2013, Hood River photographer Peter Marbach will participate in the Oregon Project Dayshoot 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event by documenting life in and around Hood River, Oregon.

Marbach is taking part in a historic statewide project that will take place from midnight to midnight on July 15. “It’s an honor to be invited to participate in this project,” Marbach said. “I look forward to the challenge of coming up with images that capture a slice of the beauty and every day joy of life in Hood River County.”

More than 100 photographers and videographers will collect images that show a “day in the life” of Oregon which will be displayed online and in a physical exhibit, and will become part of the permanent collection of the Oregon Historical Society.
